Executive Summary

Happened on the 14th of December 2024 at Kura Kura Bali, Indonesia, the **Tri Hita Karana Universal Reflection Journey (THK U)** initiated a transformative “un-movement” calling to pause, reflect and re-connect as humans. Aligned with the **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)** and the **Balinese philosophy of "Three Ways to Happiness"**, the event aimed to strengthening collective actions through *open Mind*, *open Heart* and *open Will*. Key activities included blessing ceremonies and dances, mindfulness sessions, global storytellings, self-reflections and multifaith dialogues. On the day of Tumpek Kandang of the balinese calendar on the island of paradise, participants from all around the world joined in a global collective moment for People and Planet in Partnership for Peace and Prosperity.

On November 26, 2024, the **People's Consultative Assembly of the Republic of Indonesia (MPR RI)** hosted the Pre-Inauguration of **Kebangsaan dan Pembangunan Berkelanjutan (KKPB)**, or **Nationhood and Sustainable Development**, in Jakarta, Indonesia. Facilitated by SDSN Southeast Asia and the United in Diversity (UID) Foundation, this event represents a significant step in integrating Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) within Indonesia's governance framework and legislative measures.

In his closing remarks, **Ahmad Muzani**, Chairperson of MPR RI, underscored the caucus's pivotal role in optimizing development outcomes. He stated, "This caucus aims to achieve optimal development outcomes through unity, with the 4 National Pillars — NKRI, Pancasila, UUD 1945, and Bhineka Tunggal Ika — serving as the foundation."

The **Bali Interfaith Movement (BIM)** is an initiative rooted in Bali, Indonesia, that promotes interfaith dialogue, harmony, and collaboration among diverse religious and spiritual communities.

The movement likely focuses on fostering understanding and respect among the various religions, including Hinduism, Islam, Christianity, Buddhism, and other local spiritual practices. Through activities like forums, workshops, cultural events, and collaborative projects, BIM seeks to address challenges related to interfaith relations, prevent religious conflict, and build a culture of peace and mutual respect.

BIM is coming of the aftermath of the 2024 **Istiqlal Joint Declaration** signed by **Pope Francis**, as the Supreme Leader of the Catholic Church, and **Nasaruddin Umar**, the Grand Imam of the Istiqlal Mosque of Jakarta on September 5th 2024 in Indonesia. Both religious leaders reaffirmed at that time their commitment to fight against dehumanization and global warming for the sake of humanity.

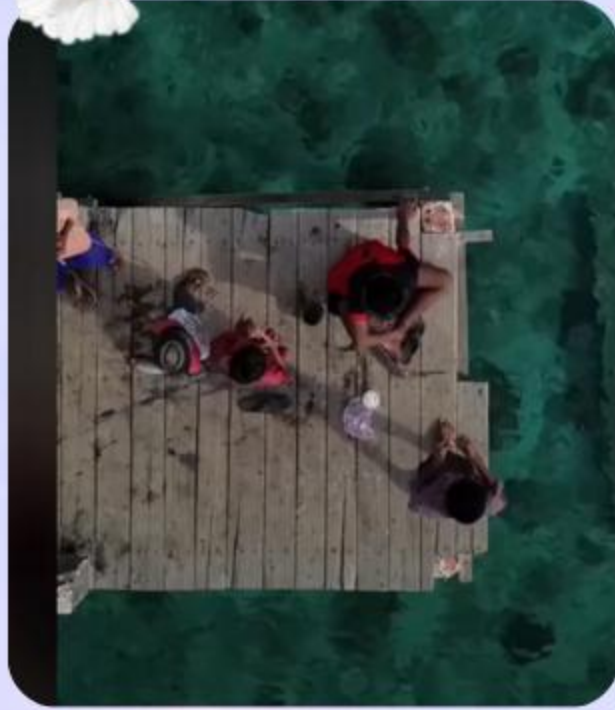

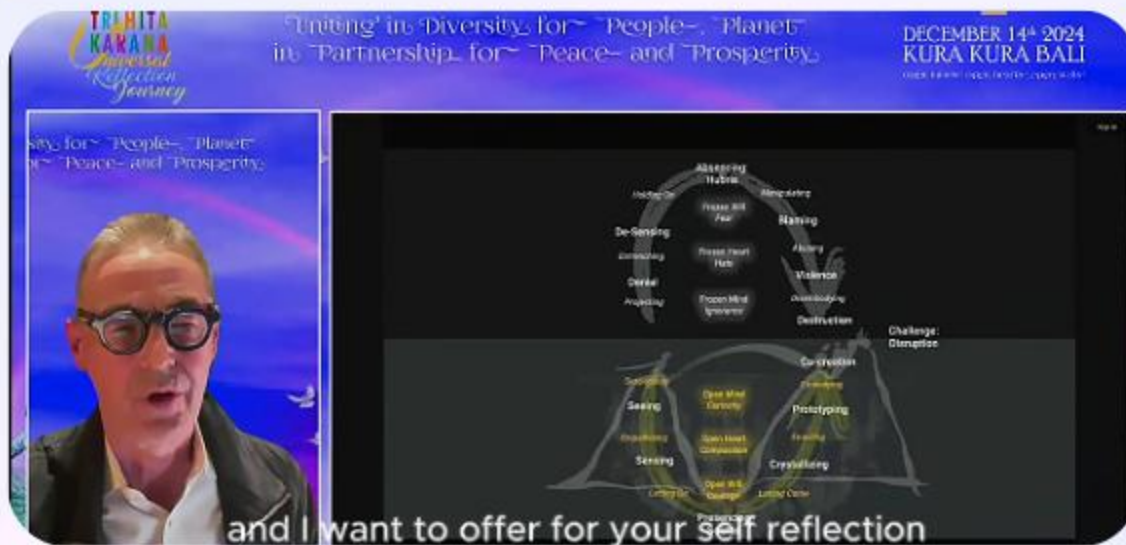

Storytelling Immersion to the Global Movement

The session fostered connection and reflection by guiding participants to share **personal stories**. It included small-group storytelling, an embodied mirroring exercise for trust and connection, and large-group sharing for collective insights.

Participants used the Mentimeter platform to write a single sentence about their experience, creating opportunities for resonance. The session closes with **reflective silence** to absorb insights and set intentions.

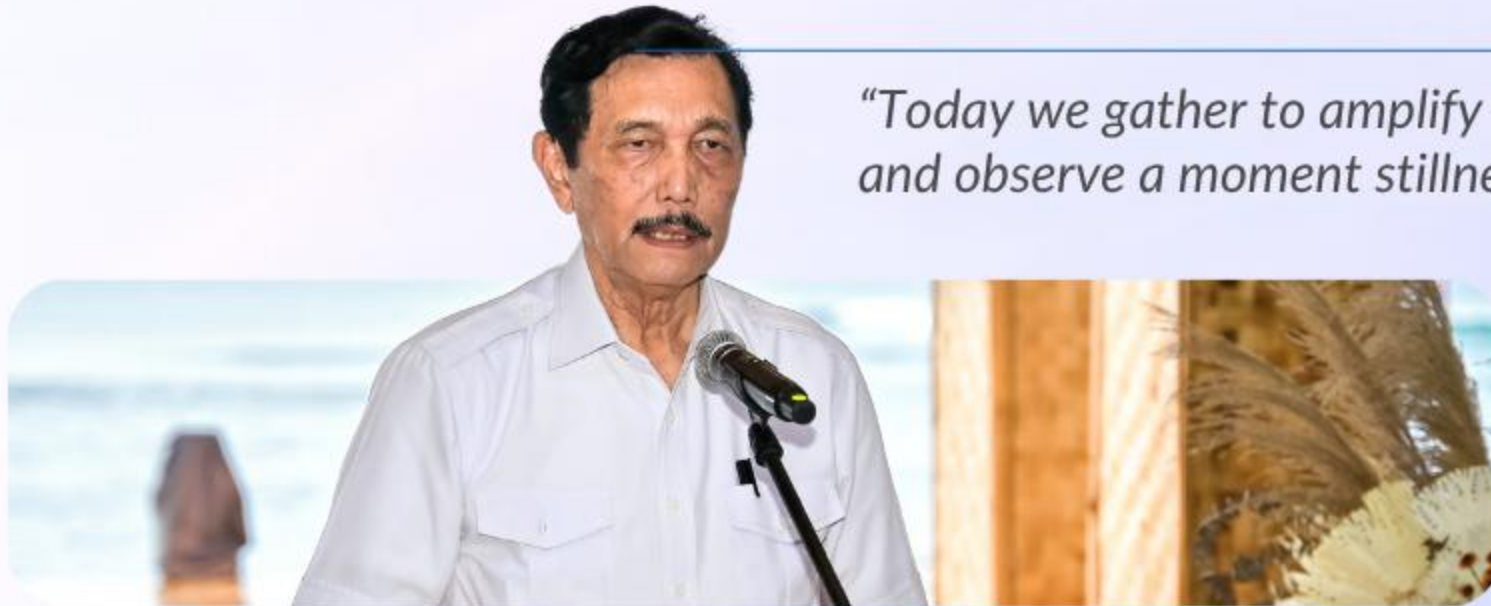
Dance of Peace Ceremony with gamelan performance

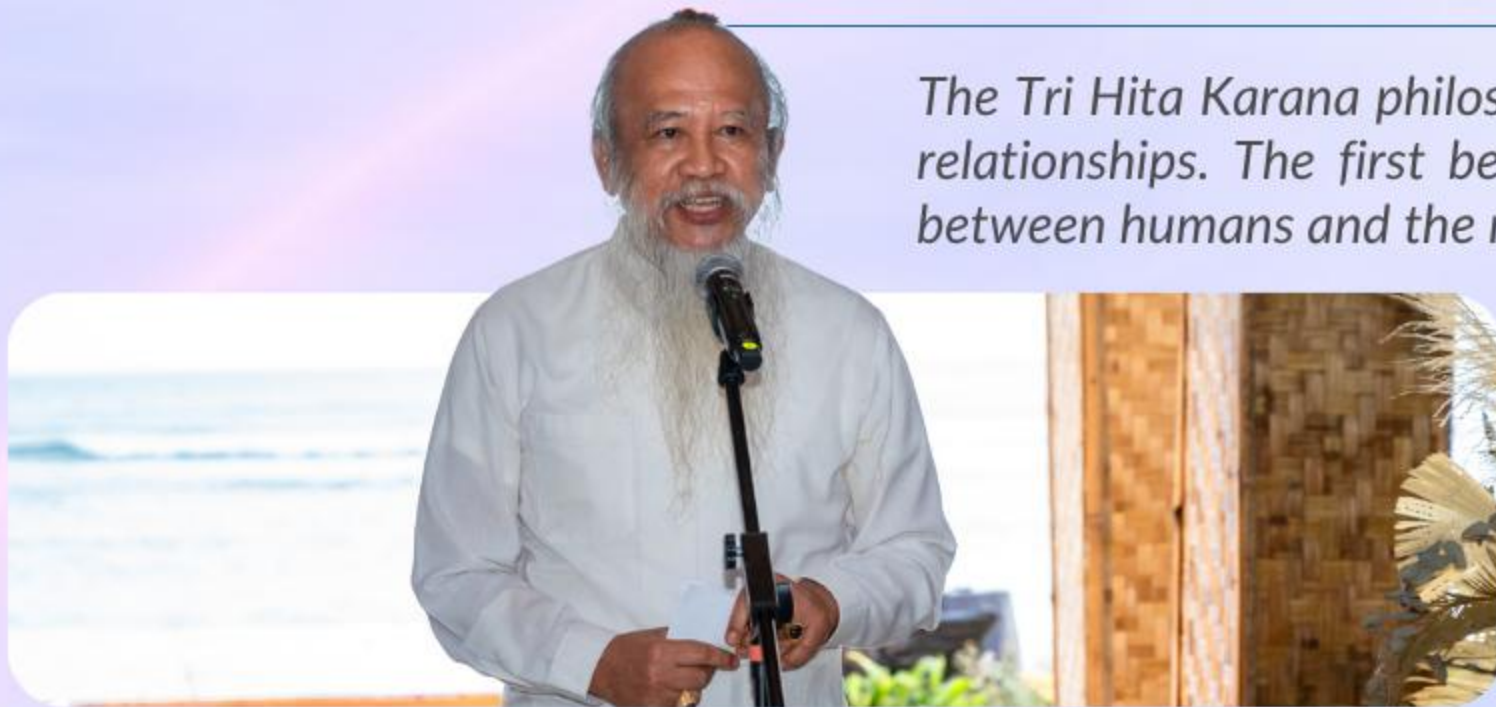

Dinner served to all the participants followed by informal discussions and connections.

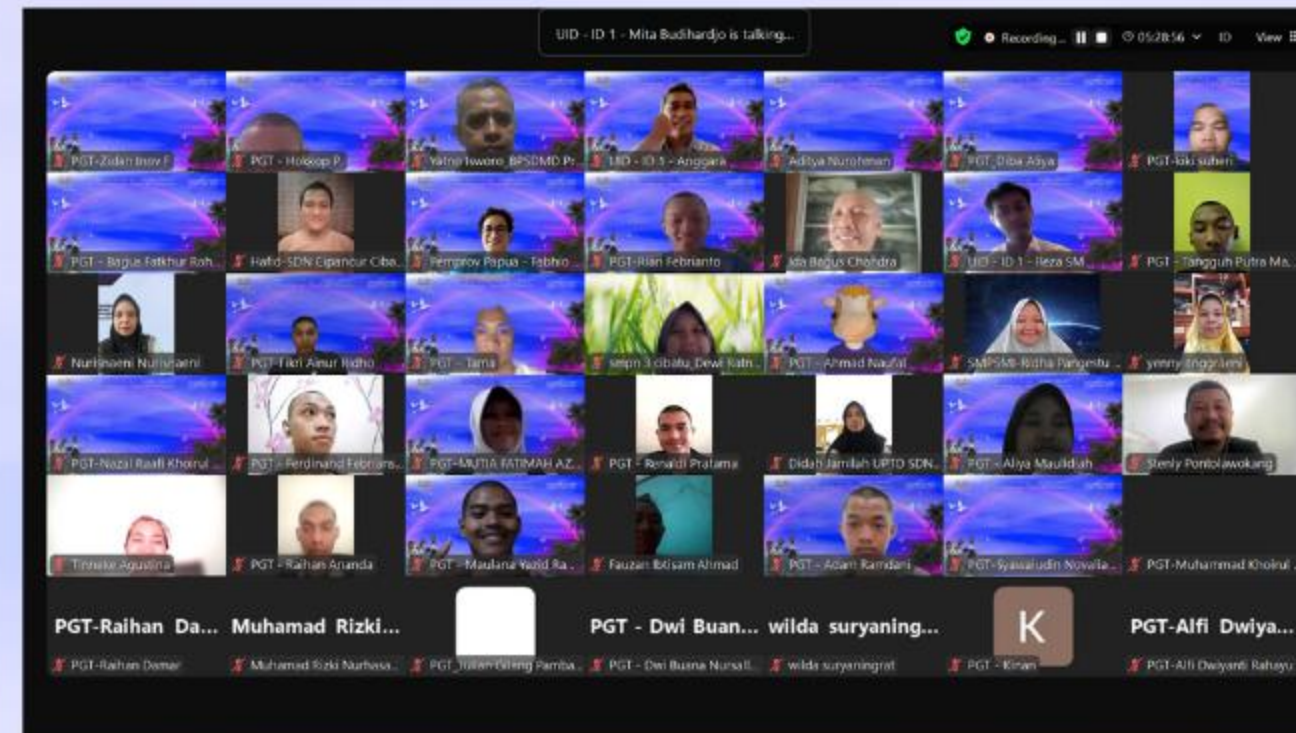
